Around 120 medicinal trees and shrubs including Rudraksh (Elaeocarpus sphericus), Kusum (Schleichera oleosa), Putranjiva (Putranjiva roxburghii), Red Sanders (Pterocarpus santalinus), Satavari (Asparagus racemosus), Arjun (Terminalia arjuna), Bael (Aegle marmelos) were planted during Van Mahotsav.

Dr Shashi Kumar planted a sapling of Rudraksh, while Dr Savita planted a sapling of Kusum. During his speech, Dr Shashi Kumar emphasized the culture of tree plantation has to be inculcated in the minds of children, students and youngsters, so that the custom of planting trees in cities and urban premises would transmit to future generations to come.
